| 1-19 | SECTION 2. Section 271.9051(a), Local Government Code, is |

| 1-24 | affixed to real property. |
| 1-25 | SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to |
| 1-26 | a contract for which the initial notice soliciting bids is given on |
| 1-27 | or after the effective date of this Act. A contract for which the |
| 1-28 | initial notice soliciting bids is given before that date is |
| 1-29 | governed by the law in effect when the initial notice is given, and |

| 1-31 | SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 1-32 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
