- 2 relating to requirements regarding information to be provided to
- 3 employees covered by workers' compensation health care networks.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1305.103(c), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (c) An employee who lives within the service area of a
- 8 network and who is being treated by a non-network provider for an
- 9 injury that occurred before the employer's insurance carrier
- 10 established or contracted with the network, shall select a network
- 11 treating doctor on notification by the carrier that health care
- 12 services are being provided through the network. The carrier shall
- 13 provide to the employee all information required by Section
- 14 1305.451. If the employee fails to select a treating doctor on or
- 15 before the 14th day after the date of receipt of the information
- 16 required by Section 1305.451, the network may assign the employee a
- 17 network treating doctor. An issue regarding whether a carrier
- 18 properly provided an employee the information required by this
- 19 subsection may be resolved using the process for adjudication of
- 20 <u>disputes under Chapter 410, Labor Code, as used by the department's</u>
- 21 division of workers' compensation.
- SECTION 2. Section 1305.451, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 23 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) An issue regarding whether an employer properly

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- 1 provided an employee with the information required by this section
- 2 may be resolved using the process for adjudication of disputes
- 3 under Chapter 410, Labor Code, as used by the department's division
- 4 of workers' compensation.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
