## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the imposition of a fee for certain plastic bags
3	provided to customers by retailers to fund a grant program to
4	support local recycling efforts.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 5, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 376 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 376. DISPOSABLE PLASTIC BAG FEE; LOCAL RECYCLING
9	ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM
10	Sec. 376.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Compostable plastic bag" means a plastic bag that
12	meets or exceeds the standard for compostable plastics developed by
13	the American Society for Testing and Materials International as
14	specified in ASTM D6400-04 as that standard existed on January 1,
15	<u>2011.</u>
16	(2) "Disposable plastic bag" means a plastic carryout
17	bag that is provided by a retailer to a customer at the point of
18	sale. The term does not include a reusable plastic bag.
19	(3) "Retailer" means a person engaged in the business
20	of selling goods directly to a customer.
21	(4) "Reusable plastic bag" means a bag with handles
22	that is specifically designed and manufactured for multiple reuses
23	and is made of plastic that is at least 2.25 millimeters thick.
24	Sec. 376.002. GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The comptroller shall

- 1 establish and administer a local recycling assistance grant program
- 2 for the public purpose of supporting municipal and county recycling
- 3 efforts in this state.
- 4 (b) Only a municipality or county may apply for and receive
- 5 a grant under the program.
- 6 (c) The comptroller by rule shall establish criteria for the
- 7 awarding of grants under this section. In adopting the rules, the
- 8 comptroller must give preference to applicants that:
- 9 <u>(1) do not have a recycling program on the date of the</u>
- 10 application; or
- 11 (2) will use the grant money to expand the recycling
- 12 capacity of an existing recycling program.
- 13 (d) The comptroller shall adopt any other rules and forms
- 14 necessary for the implementation and administration of the program.
- Sec. 376.003. DISPOSABLE PLASTIC BAG FEE. Except as
- 16 provided by Section 376.004, a fee of five cents is imposed on a
- 17 customer for each disposable plastic bag provided to the customer
- 18 to carry out or protect goods purchased from a retailer.
- 19 Sec. 376.004. EXEMPTIONS. A fee may not be imposed under
- 20 Section 376.003 for:
- 21 (1) a disposable plastic bag that is used solely to
- 22 carry bulk food, produce, or meat from a department within a store
- 23 to the point of sale; or
- 24 (2) a compostable plastic bag.
- Sec. 376.005. COLLECTION BY RETAILER. (a) A retailer who
- 26 provides a disposable plastic bag to a customer shall collect the
- 27 fee imposed by Section 376.003. Except as provided by Subsection

- 1 (d), the retailer shall remit the fee to the comptroller.
- 2 (b) The retailer shall add the fee imposed by Section
- 3 376.003 to the total price of the goods sold to the customer, and
- 4 the fee is a part of the sales price, is a debt owed to the retailer
- 5 by the customer, and is recoverable at law in the same manner as the
- 6 original sales price.
- 7 (c) The amount of the fee shall be stated separately on a
- 8 sales receipt, invoice, or other record of sale.
- 9 (d) A retailer may retain three percent of the total amount
- 10 of the fees collected under Subsection (a) as reimbursement for any
- 11 costs associated with the collection of the fees.
- 12 Sec. 376.006. ADMINISTRATION, COLLECTION, AND ENFORCEMENT
- 13 BY COMPTROLLER. The comptroller shall adopt any rules for the
- 14 administration, payment, collection, and enforcement of the fee
- 15 imposed by this chapter.
- 16 Sec. 376.007. LOCAL RECYCLING PROGRAM ASSISTANCE ACCOUNT.
- 17 (a) The local recycling program assistance account is established
- 18 as an account in the general revenue fund.
- 19 (b) The comptroller shall deposit the revenue received from
- 20 the fee imposed by Section 376.003 to the credit of the account.
- (c) Money in the account may be appropriated only for the
- 22 implementation and administration of the grant program established
- 23 under Section 376.002.
- SECTION 2. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 25 section, this Act takes effect January 1, 2012.
- 26 (b) Section 376.006, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 27 this Act, takes effect September 1, 2011.
