## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of money appropriated out of the general revenue
- 3 fund for the provision of postsecondary educational programs to

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 19.005(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) Any person confined or imprisoned in the department who
- 10 is not a high school graduate is eligible for programs or services
- 11 under this chapter paid for with money from the foundation school
- 12 fund. [To the extent space is available, the district may also
- 13 offer programs or services under this chapter paid for with money
- 14 from the foundation school fund to persons confined or imprisoned
- 15 in the department who are high school graduates.
- 16 SECTION 2. Chapter 19, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 17 Section 19.0071 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 19.0071. CERTAIN USE OF APPROPRIATED MONEY PROHIBITED.
- 19 (a) In this section, "appropriated money" means money:
- 20 (1) appropriated to the district from the general
- 21 revenue fund, including money from the foundation school fund; and
- 22 (2) received by the district from the department under
- 23 Section 19.007 that was appropriated to the department from the
- 24 general revenue fund.

- 1 (b) The district may not use appropriated money to provide,
- 2 or contract for the provision of, postsecondary educational
- 3 programs, including vocational training programs, to persons who
- 4 are confined or imprisoned in the department and are high school
- 5 graduates or have high school equivalency certificates.
- 6 SECTION 3. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 493.030 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 493.030. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN APPROPRIATED MONEY
- 9 PROHIBITED. The department may not transfer any money appropriated
- 10 to the department from the general revenue fund to the Windham
- 11 School District operated under Chapter 19, Education Code, for the
- 12 purpose of the district providing, or contracting for the provision
- 13 of, postsecondary educational programs, including vocational
- 14 training programs, to persons who are confined or imprisoned in the
- 15 department and are high school graduates or have high school
- 16 <u>equivalency certificates.</u>
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
