A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the conduct of early voting by personal appearance on weekends in general and primary elections. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 85.001(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) For a special runoff election for the office of state senator or state representative [or for a runoff primary election], 8 9 the period begins on the 10th day before election day. For a runoff primary election, the period begins on the 11th day before election 10 11 day. 12 SECTION 2. Sections 85.006(a) and (c), Election Code, are amended to read as follows: 13 14 (a) The [Except as provided by Subsection (b), the] authority ordering an election shall [may] order early voting by 15 16 personal appearance at the main early voting polling place to be conducted on one or more Saturdays and one or more [or] Sundays 17 during the early voting period. 18 The authority ordering an election [voting on a Saturday 19 (c) or Sunday] shall determine the hours during which voting is to be 20 conducted on Saturday and on Sunday. 21 SECTION 3. Sections 85.006(b) and (d), Election Code, are 22 23 repealed. SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 24

1 an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.

2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
