- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 78, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER D. LIABILITY FOR TRAINING EXERCISES
- 9 Sec. 78.151. LIABILITY FOR TRAINING EXERCISES. A person is
- 10 not liable for damages resulting from the person's execution of a
- 11 training exercise intended to prepare the person to respond to a
- 12 fire or emergency to which this chapter applies to the same extent
- 13 that the person would not be liable under this chapter for damages
- 14 resulting from the person's actions in responding to a fire or
- 15 emergency.
- 16 SECTION 2. Chapter 79, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 79.004 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 79.004. LIABILITY FOR TRAINING EXERCISES. Except in a
- 19 case of reckless conduct or intentional, wilful, or wanton
- 20 misconduct, a person who is immune from civil liability for an act
- 21 or omission that occurs in giving care, assistance, or advice with
- 22 respect to the management of an incident to which this chapter
- 23 applies is immune from civil liability for an act or omission that
- 24 occurs during the execution of a training exercise intended to

- 1 prepare the person to give that care, assistance, or advice.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act applies to an act or omission in
- 3 relation to a training exercise the execution of which begins on or
- 4 after the effective date of this Act, without regard to whether the
- 5 planning or scheduling of the exercise took place before, on, or
- 6 after that date.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
