- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.092(d), Penal Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that:
- 8 (1) the actor had a reasonable fear of:
- 9 <u>(A)</u> bodily injury to the actor or to another
- 10 person by a dangerous wild animal as defined by Section 822.101,
- 11 Health and Safety Code; or
- 12 (B) serious bodily injury to the actor or to
- 13 another person by a dog as defined by Section 822.041, Health and
- 14 Safety Code; or
- 15 (2) the actor was engaged in bona fide experimentation
- 16 for scientific research.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 21 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes
- 22 of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date
- 23 of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
