- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 370, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 370.2511 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 370.2511. BOARD OF DIRECTORS: CERTAIN AUTHORITIES. (a)
- 8 This section applies only to an authority created by a
- 9 municipality.
- 10 (b) The governing body of a municipality by order may
- 11 establish the governing body as the board of directors of an
- 12 authority.
- 13 <u>(c) If the board of directors of an authority created by a</u>
- 14 municipality consists of the members of the governing body of the
- 15 municipality, the presiding officers of the governing body of the
- 16 municipality are the presiding officers of the board.
- 17 <u>(d) Each director of a board under this section has equal</u>
- 18 status and may vote.
- 19 (e) The vote of a majority attending a board meeting is
- 20 necessary for any action taken by a board under this section. If a
- 21 vacancy exists on a board, the majority of directors serving on the
- 22 board is a quorum.
- 23 (f) The governing body of a municipality that becomes the
- 24 board of an existing authority under this section shall by

- 1 resolution provide for the transfer process that establishes the
- 2 governing body as the board of the authority.
- 3 (g) If the board of directors of an authority created by a
- 4 municipality consists of the members of the governing body of the
- 5 <u>municipality</u>, <u>Sections 370.251</u>, <u>370.2515</u>, <u>370.252</u>, <u>370.2521</u>,
- 6 370.2522, 370.2523, 370.253, 370.254, and 370.255 do not apply to
- 7 the board.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
