- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 11.004 to read as follows:
- Sec. 11.004. TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN UNFUNDED 8
- 9 STATE EDUCATIONAL MANDATES. (a) In this section, "state
- educational mandate" means a statutory provision the 10
- implementation of which requires an expenditure by a school 11
- district that would not have been required in the absence of the 12
- statutory provision or a rule adopted under that provision. 13
- 14 (b) A school district is exempt from a state educational
- mandate for which the legislature, for the state fiscal biennium, 15
- 16 has not appropriated money estimated to be sufficient to meet the
- expenditure required by the mandate for that biennium unless the 17
- mandate is necessary either to comply with federal law or to meet 18
- eligibility standards for a federal entitlement that is sufficient 19
- to meet the full expenditure required by the mandate, and the 20
- federal law specifically contemplates action by a district for 21
- compliance or eligibility. 22
- 23 (c) This section expires September 1, 2013.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
