Damages 19 20 under this section begin to accrue on the date on which the insurer 21 becomes liable for failure to comply with this subchapter as determined under Section 542.058 and continue to accrue until the 22 23 date on which the unpaid balance of the claim is paid. 24 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by Section 541.152,

Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an action for damages arising from an act or practice that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. An action for damages for an act or practice that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

The change in law made by Section 542.060, Insurance 7 (b) 8 Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to liability for a violation of Subchapter B, Chapter 542, Insurance Code, as amended 9 by this Act, that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. 10 Liability for a violation of Subchapter B, Chapter 542, Insurance 11 Code, that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed 12 by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is 13 14 continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
