A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the sheriff's department civil service commission

- 3 appointments in certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 158.034(a) and (c), Local Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In a county with a population of less than 3.3 [2.8]
- 8 million, if a majority of the employees voting at the election
- 9 approve the creation of a sheriff's department civil service
- 10 system, the sheriff shall appoint two persons and the $[\tau]$
- 11 commissioners court, [and] district attorney, and employee
- 12 <u>organization representing the majority of sheriff's department</u>
- 13 <u>employees</u> shall each appoint one person to serve as a member of the
- 14 civil service commission that administers the system. In a county
- 15 with a population of 3.3 [2.8] million or more, if a majority of the
- 16 employees voting at the election approve the creation of a
- 17 sheriff's department civil service system, the sheriff,
- 18 commissioners court, and district attorney shall each appoint two
- 19 persons to serve as members of the civil service commission that
- 20 administers the system, and the three appointing authorities shall
- 21 appoint one member by joint action requiring the affirmative vote
- 22 of each of the authorities.
- (c) Each member of the commission is appointed for a term of
- 24 two years. However, the initial members of the commission in a

- 1 county with a population of less than 3.3 [2.8] million shall
- 2 determine by lot which two of them will serve a term of two years and
- 3 which one of them will serve a term of one year. In a county with a
- 4 population of 3.3 [2.8] million or more:
- 5 (1) the initial member appointed jointly under
- 6 Subsection (a) serves a term of two years; and
- 7 (2) the initial members appointed by each individual
- 8 appointing authority shall determine by lot which one of the two
- 9 initial members appointed by the appointing authority will serve a
- 10 term of two years and which initial member appointed by that
- 11 authority will serve a term of one year.
- 12 SECTION 2. In a county with a population of less than 3.3
- 13 million to which Section 158.034, Local Government Code, as amended
- 14 by this Act, applies and in which a sheriff's department civil
- 15 service system commission exists before the effective date of this
- 16 Act, the sheriff and the employee organization shall each appoint
- 17 one member to the commission. The five members composed of the
- 18 current three members and the two new members shall then determine
- 19 by agreement or lot which three of them will serve a term of two
- 20 years and which two of them will serve a term of one year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
