- 5 SECTION 1. Section 501.003, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 501.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The office is subject to
- 8 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued
- 9 in existence as provided by that chapter, the office is abolished
- 10 September 1, 2023 [2011].
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 501, Insurance Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 501.160 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 501.160. ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCEDURES.
- 14 (a) The office shall develop and implement a policy to encourage
- 15 the use of appropriate alternative dispute resolution procedures
- 16 <u>under Chapter 2009, Government Code,</u> to assist in the resolution of
- 17 internal and external disputes under the office's jurisdiction.
- 18 (b) The office's procedures relating to alternative dispute
- 19 resolution must conform, to the extent possible, to model
- 20 guidelines issued by the State Office of Administrative Hearings
- 21 for the use of alternative dispute resolution procedures by state
- 22 agencies.
- 23 (c) The office shall:
- 24 (1) coordinate the implementation of the policy

- 1 adopted under Subsection (a);
- 2 (2) provide training as needed to implement the
- 3 procedures for negotiated rulemaking or alternative dispute
- 4 resolution; and
- 5 (3) collect data concerning the effectiveness of those
- 6 procedures.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
