Section 106.14, Alcoholic Beverage Code, 5 is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 6 7 (e) After notice and hearing, the commission may cancel or suspend the commission's approval of a seller training program, the 8 9 commission's certification of a trainer to teach a seller training program, or the commission's certification of a seller-server if 10 the program, trainer, or seller-server violates this code or a 11 12 commission rule. The commission may give a program, trainer, or seller-server the opportunity to pay a civil penalty rather than be 13 14 subject to suspension under this subsection. Sections 11.62 through 11.67 apply to the program approval or certification as if 15 16 the program approval or certification were a license or permit under this code. 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20
