- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.391(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) An applicant for a permit issued under this code for a
- 8 location not previously licensed for the on-premises consumption of
- 9 alcoholic beverages must [shall], not later than the 60th day
- 10 before the date the permit [application] is issued [filed],
- 11 prominently post an outdoor sign at the location stating that
- 12 alcoholic beverages are intended to be served on the premises, the
- 13 type of permit, and the name and business address of the applicant.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 61.381(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) An applicant for a license issued under this code for a
- 17 location not previously licensed for the on-premises consumption of
- 18 alcoholic beverages $\underline{\text{must}}$ [$\underline{\text{shall}}$], not later than the 60th day
- 19 before the date the license [application] is license [filed],
- 20 prominently post an outdoor sign at the location stating that
- 21 alcoholic beverages are intended to be served on the premises, the
- 22 type of license, and the name and business address of the applicant.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an application for an alcoholic beverage permit or license filed

- 1 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application filed
- 2 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 3 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 4 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
