- 2 relating to appeal from certain orders of the Texas Alcoholic

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 11.67(a) and (b), Alcoholic Beverage
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) An appeal from an order of the commission or
- 8 administrator refusing, cancelling, or suspending a permit or
- 9 license or forfeiting a conduct surety bond may be taken to the
- 10 district court of the county in which the applicant, licensee, or
- 11 permittee resides or in which the owner of involved real or personal
- 12 property resides.
- 13 (b) The appeal shall be under the substantial evidence rule
- 14 and against the commission alone as defendant. The rules
- 15 applicable to ordinary civil suits apply, with the following
- 16 exceptions, which shall be construed literally:
- 17 (1) the appeal shall be perfected and filed within 30
- 18 days after the date the order, decision, or ruling of the commission
- 19 or administrator becomes final and appealable;
- 20 (2) the case shall be tried before a judge within <u>60</u>
- 21 [10] days from the date it is filed;
- 22 (3) neither party is entitled to a jury; and
- 23 (4) the order, decision, or ruling of the commission
- 24 or administrator may be suspended or modified by the court pending a

- 1 trial on the merits, but the final judgment of the district court
- 2 may not be modified or suspended pending appeal.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 61.81, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 61.81. APPEAL FROM CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION, OR
- 6 REFUSAL OF LICENSE. Section 11.67 of this code applies to an appeal
- 7 from a decision or order of the commission or administrator
- 8 refusing, cancelling, or suspending a license or forfeiting a
- 9 surety bond.
- SECTION 3. (a) Sections 11.67(a) and 61.81, Alcoholic
- 11 Beverage Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to an appeal of an
- 12 order issued on or after the effective date of this Act. Appeal of
- 13 an order issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 14 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 15 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 16 (b) Section 11.67(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, as amended
- 17 by this Act, applies only to an appeal filed on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act. An appeal filed before the effective
- 19 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before
- 20 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 21 for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
