A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to investigations of violations of and complaints and
- 3 protests under the Alcoholic Beverage Code.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5.36. INVESTIGATION OF VIOLATIONS, COMPLAINTS, AND
- 8 PROTESTS. (a) The commission shall investigate violations of this
- 9 code and of other laws relating to alcoholic beverages, and shall
- 10 cooperate in the prosecution of offenders before any court of
- 11 competent jurisdiction. The commission may seize alcoholic
- 12 beverages manufactured, sold, kept, imported, or transported in
- 13 violation of this code and apply for the confiscation of the
- 14 beverages if required to do so by this code.
- 15 (b) A complaint alleging a violation of this code or another
- 16 law relating to alcoholic beverages or a protest of the issuance or
- 17 renewal of a permit or license under this code must include the
- 18 <u>legal and factual information that forms the basis of the complaint</u>
- 19 <u>or protest.</u>
- 20 <u>(c) Not later than the fifth business day after the date the</u>
- 21 commission receives a complaint alleging a violation of this code
- 22 or another law relating to alcoholic beverages, a protest of the
- 23 issuance or renewal of a permit or license under this code, or an
- 24 application for an original or renewal permit or license under this

- 1 code, the commission shall initiate an investigation of the
- 2 complaint or protest or a potential violation of this code or a
- 3 commission rule by the applicant who submitted the application.
- 4 (d) The commission must complete an investigation initiated
- 5 under Subsection (c) not later than the 30th calendar day after the
- 6 date the complaint, protest, or application is received by the
- 7 <u>commission</u>.
- 8 <u>(e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), but</u>
- 9 notwithstanding any other provision of this code, any hearing
- 10 conducted under this code on a complaint, protest, or application
- 11 described by this section must be held not later than the 60th
- 12 calendar day after the date the complaint, protest, or application
- 13 <u>is received by the commission. Unless the deadline is waived under</u>
- 14 Subsection (f), if a hearing on a complaint, protest, or
- 15 application described by this section is not held by the deadline
- 16 imposed by this subsection, the complaint or protest shall be
- 17 dismissed or the application is considered approved and the permit
- 18 or license applied for shall be issued.
- 19 (f) A permittee, licensee, or applicant that is the subject
- 20 of a complaint, protest, or application described by this section
- 21 may waive the deadline to conduct a hearing imposed by Subsection
- 22 (e) by filing a written request with the commission before the 60th
- 23 calendar day after the date the complaint, protest, or application
- 24 is received by the commission. If the deadline imposed by
- 25 Subsection (e) is waived under this subsection, the commission must
- 26 allow sufficient additional time before scheduling the hearing for
- 27 the completion of discovery and other prehearing proceedings

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- 1 authorized by law or the rules of the State Office of Administrative
- 2 Hearings.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 5.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as 4 amended by this Act, applies only to a complaint, protest, or
- 5 application received by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission on
- 6 or after the effective date of this Act. A complaint, protest, or
- 7 application received before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 9 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
