A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the periodic review of the child support guidelines.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 111.001, Family Code, is amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Sec. 111.001. REVIEW OF GUIDELINES. (a) Prior to each
- 7 regular legislative session, the standing committees of each house
- 8 of the legislature having jurisdiction over family law issues shall
- 9 review and, if necessary, recommend revisions to the guidelines for
- 10 possession of and access to a child under Chapter 153 [and for
- 11 support of a child under Chapter 154]. The committee shall report
- 12 the results of the review and shall include any recommended
- 13 revisions in the committee's report to the legislature.
- 14 (b) At least once every four years [Not later than December
- 15 1 of each even-numbered year], the Title IV-D agency shall review
- 16 the child support guidelines under Chapter 154 as required by 42
- 17 U.S.C. Section 667(a) and report the results of the review and any
- 18 recommendations for changes to the guidelines or their manner of
- 19 <u>application</u> [submit a report] to the standing committees of each
- 20 house of the legislature having jurisdiction over family law issues
- 21 [for use by the committee in conducting the review required by
- 22 Subsection (a). The report must contain:
- [(1) economic data obtained from the United States
- 24 Department of Agriculture on the cost of raising children;

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- 1 [(2) an analysis of case data on the application of and
- 2 deviations from the child support guidelines; and
- 3 [(3) a summary of any federal legislation enacted
- 4 since the date of the last review].
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
