8	The commission by rule may set and collect a fee for any service
9	provided [charge a fee, as provided by commission rule, for an
10	<pre>inspection made] by the commission, including:</pre>
11	(1) the inspection of animals or facilities;
12	(2) the testing of animals for disease;
13	(3) obtaining samples from animals for disease
14	testing;
15	(4) disease prevention, control or eradication, and
16	<pre>treatment efforts;</pre>
17	(5) services related to the transport of livestock;
18	(6) control and eradication of ticks and other pests;
19	and
20	(7) any other service for which the commission incurs
21	<u>a cost</u> .
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
