A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to safety measures for certain public and private school
- 3 extracurricular activities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 33.201, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.201. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies to
- 8 each public school in this state and to any other school in this
- 9 state subject to rules or bylaws of:
- 10 <u>(1) the</u> University Interscholastic League; or
- 11 (2) the Texas Association of Private and Parochial
- 12 <u>Schools</u> [rules].
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 33.2011 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 33.2011. REFERENCE INCLUDES SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION. A
- 16 reference in this subchapter to the Texas Association of Private
- 17 and Parochial Schools includes an organization that is a successor
- 18 to that association.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 33.202(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (c) The safety training program must include:
- 22 (1) certification of participants by, as determined by
- 23 the commissioner:
- 24 (A) the American Red Cross, the American Heart

- 1 Association, or a similar organization; or
- 2 <u>(B)</u> the University Interscholastic League or the
- 3 Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools, as applicable
- 4 [determined by the commissioner];
- 5 (2) current training in:
- 6 (A) emergency action planning;
- 7 (B) cardiopulmonary resuscitation if the person
- 8 is not required to obtain certification under Section 33.086;
- 9 (C) communicating effectively with 9-1-1
- 10 emergency service operators and other emergency personnel; and
- 11 (D) recognizing symptoms of potentially
- 12 catastrophic injuries, including head and neck injuries,
- 13 concussions, injuries related to second impact syndrome, asthma
- 14 attacks, heatstroke, cardiac arrest, and injuries requiring use of
- 15 a defibrillator; and
- 16 (3) at least once each school year, a safety drill that
- 17 incorporates the training described by Subdivision (2) and
- 18 simulates various injuries described by Subdivision (2)(D).
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 33.203, Education Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 33.203. COMPLETION OF UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC
- 22 LEAGUE FORMS. (a) Each student participating in an
- 23 extracurricular athletic activity must complete the University
- 24 Interscholastic League forms entitled "Preparticipation Physical
- 25 Evaluation--Medical History" and "Acknowledgment of Rules[$_{f ext{+}}$]" or
- 26 equivalent forms of the Texas Association of Private and Parochial
- 27 Schools, as applicable. Each form must be signed by both the

- 1 student and the student's parent or guardian.
- 2 (b) Each form specified by Subsection (a) must clearly state
- 3 that failure to accurately and truthfully answer all questions on a
- 4 form required by statute, [or by] the University Interscholastic
- 5 League, or the Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools,
- 6 as applicable, as a condition for participation in an
- 7 extracurricular athletic activity subjects a signer of the form to
- 8 penalties determined by the University Interscholastic League or
- 9 the Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools, as
- 10 <u>applicable</u>.
- SECTION 5. Section 33.205(b), Education Code, is amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 (b) If a student participating in an extracurricular
- 14 athletic activity, including a practice or competition, becomes
- 15 unconscious or is suspected of having sustained a concussion during
- 16 the activity, the student may not:
- 17 (1) return to the practice or competition during which
- 18 the student became unconscious or is suspected of having sustained
- 19 <u>a concussion</u>; or
- 20 (2) participate in any extracurricular athletic
- 21 activity until the student receives written authorization for such
- 22 participation from a physician.
- SECTION 6. Sections 33.206(a) and (c), Education Code, are
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- 25 (a) A [In accordance with Chapter 552, Government Code, a]
- 26 school shall make available to the public proof of compliance for
- 27 each person enrolled in, employed by, or volunteering for the

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- 1 school who is required to receive safety training described by
- 2 Section 33.202. In complying with this subsection, a public school
- 3 shall act in accordance with Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 4 (c) A school campus that is determined by the school's
- 5 superintendent or director to be out of compliance with Section
- 6 33.202, 33.204, or 33.205 with regard to applicable University
- 7 Interscholastic League <u>or Texas Association of Private and</u>
- 8 Parochial Schools activities shall be subject to the range of
- 9 penalties determined by the University Interscholastic League or
- 10 the Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools, as
- 11 <u>applicable</u>.
- 12 SECTION 7. Section 33.208(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) A school that offers an extracurricular athletic
- 15 activity shall provide to each student participating in an
- 16 extracurricular athletic activity and to the student's parent or
- 17 guardian a copy of the text of Sections 33.201, 33.202, 33.203,
- 18 33.204, 33.205, 33.206, and 33.207 [33.201-33.207] and a copy of,
- 19 as applicable, the University Interscholastic League's or Texas
- 20 <u>Association of Private and Parochial Schools'</u> parent information
- 21 manual.
- SECTION 8. Section 33.209, Education Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 33.209. INCORPORATION OF SAFETY REGULATIONS. The
- 25 University Interscholastic League and the Texas Association of
- 26 Private and Parochial Schools shall incorporate the provisions of
- 27 Sections 33.201, 33.202, 33.203, 33.204, 33.205, 33.206, and 33.207

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- 1 [33.203-33.207] into the league's or school's constitution, bylaws,
- 2 and contest rules, as applicable.
- 3 SECTION 9. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 6 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 7 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 8 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 9 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
