4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.126 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 361.126. DISPOSAL OF DEMOLITION WASTE FROM ABANDONED
8	OR NUISANCE BUILDING. (a) The commission may issue a permit by
9	rule to authorize the governing body of a county or municipality
10	with a population of 10,000 or less to dispose of demolition waste
11	from an abandoned building or building found to be a nuisance if the
12	disposal occurs on land that:
13	(1) the county or municipality owns or controls; and
14	(2) would qualify for an arid exemption under
15	commission rules.
16	(b) The commission may adopt rules under Section 361.024 to
17	control the collection, handling, storage, processing, and
18	disposal of demolition waste under this section to protect public
19	and private property, rights-of-way, groundwater, and any other
20	right that requires protection.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
