Section 33.006(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) A certificate of appointment must: (1) be in writing and signed by the appointing 8 9 authority or, for an appointment for a write-in candidate under Section 33.004, by each of the voters making the appointment; 10 11 (2) indicate the capacity in which the appointing 12 authority is acting; 13 (3) state the name, residence address, and voter 14 registration number of the appointee and be signed by the 15 appointee; (4) identify the election and the precinct polling 16 place or other location at which the appointee is to serve; and 17 18 (5) in an election on a measure, identify the measure if more than one is to be voted on and state which side of the 19 20 measure the appointee represents [; and 21 [(6) contain an affidavit executed by the appointee 22 stating that the appointee will not have possession of anv 23 mechanical or electronic means of recording images or sound while serving as a watcher]. 24

Section 61.014(d), Election Code, is amended to 1 2 read as follows: 3 (d) This section does not apply to: 4 (1) an election officer in conducting the officer's 5 official duties; 6 (2) the use of election equipment necessary for the 7 conduct of the election; [or] 8 (3) a person who is employed at the location in which a polling place is located while the person is acting in the course of 9 10 the person's employment; or (4) a poll watcher who, in a manner that does not 11 12 disrupt proceedings at or near the voting station and for the purpose of reporting an irregularity or violation of law relating 13 14 to the election, is contacting the authority holding the election, 15 the secretary of state, the attorney general, or a law enforcement officer. 16 17 SECTION 3. Section 33.051(c), Election Code, is repealed. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011. 18
