## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the offense of unacknowledged assistance to a voter in
- 3 completing an application for a ballot to be voted by mail.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 84.003(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) A person who acts as a witness for an applicant for an
- 8 early voting ballot application commits an offense if the person
- 9 knowingly fails to comply with Section 1.011. A person who [in the
- 10 presence of the applicant] otherwise assists an applicant in
- 11 completing an early voting ballot application commits an offense if
- 12 the person knowingly fails to comply with Section 1.011(d) in the
- 13 same manner as a witness.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 18 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 19 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 21 before that date.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
