The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 13 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 14 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 15 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 17 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 18 before that date. 19 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
