H.B. No. 2060

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the confidentiality of certain information regarding  
3 state election inspectors.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 34.001(a) and (c), Election Code, are  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The secretary of state may appoint one or more state  
8 inspectors for an election. The appointment is, until the day after  
9 election day, confidential and not available for public inspection.

10 (c) A request under Subsection (b) must be received by the  
11 secretary of state not later than the fourth regular business day  
12 before the date of the election for which the inspectors are  
13 requested. The request is, until the day after election day,  
14 confidential and not available for public inspection [~~until the day~~  
15 ~~after election day~~].

16 SECTION 2. Chapter 34, Election Code, is amended by adding  
17 Section 34.006 to read as follows:

18 Sec. 34.006. PLACES INSPECTED CONFIDENTIAL. Information  
19 held by the secretary of state that indicates the place a state  
20 inspector has been appointed to inspect is, during the period  
21 beginning on the day the state inspector is appointed and ending on  
22 the day after election day, confidential and not available for  
23 public inspection.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
