H.B. No. 2061

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the reporting of certain information to the director of
3 the bureau of vital statistics.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 191.024(a), Health and Safety Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) On the state registrar's demand, a person, including a
8 local registrar, physician, midwife, or funeral director, who has
9 information relating to a birth, death, or fetal death shall supply
10 the information to the state registrar in person, by mail, or
11 through the local registrar. The person shall supply the
12 information on a form provided by the department or on the original
13 certificate.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
