1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the reporting of certain information to the director of
1-9 the bureau of vital statistics.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 191.024(a), Health and Safety Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) On the state registrar's demand, a person, including a
1-14 local registrar, physician, midwife, or funeral director, who has
1-15 information relating to a birth, death, or fetal death shall supply
1-16 the information to the state registrar in person, by mail, or
1-17 through the local registrar. The person shall supply the
1-18 information on a form provided by the department or on the original
1-19 certificate.

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
