H.B. No. 2066

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to delegation by a physician of certain cosmetic and
3 dermatological medical treatments.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 157, Occupations Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 157.008 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 157.008. DELEGATION OF COSMETIC AND DERMATOLOGICAL
8 MEDICAL TREATMENTS. (a) A physician may delegate to a qualified,
9 properly trained, and supervised physician assistant or advanced
10 practice nurse or another qualified, properly trained, and
11 supervised individual the administration of a U.S. Food and Drug
12 Administration approved pharmaceutical injectable botulinum toxin
13 or dermal filler.

14 (b) The administration of a medical treatment described by
15 Subsection (a) must be in compliance with Section 157.001 and any
16 other law relating to the practice of medicine and state and federal
17 laws relating to the administration of a medical treatment.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
