A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1001, Occupations Code, is |
| 6 | amended by adding Section 1001.068 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 1001.068. CERTAIN OUT-OF-STATE ENGINEERS ENGAGED IN |
| 8 | EVALUATING OIL AND GAS RESOURCES. (a) In this section, "evaluation |
| 9 | of oil and gas resources" includes: |
| 10 | (1) the quantification of the volume of oil and gas |
| 11 | reserves and resources in the subsurface of the earth; |
| 12 | (2) the determination of production forecasts for the |
| 13 | reserves or resources; and |
| 14 | (3) the evaluation of the economic impact of the |
| 15 | production forecasts. |
| 16 | (b) This chapter does not apply to the evaluation of oil and |
| 17 | gas resources if the evaluation: |
| 18 | (1) is done by an engineer licensed in a state that |
| 19 | does not prohibit engineers licensed under this chapter from |
| 20 | engaging in the evaluation of oil and gas resources in that state; |
| 21 | (2) does not involve design, construction, or |
| 22 | engineering assessments on the surface; and |
| 23 | (3) does not present a risk to public health or safety. |
| 24 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
