Subchapter B, Chapter 1001, Occupations Code, is 1-12 amended by adding Section 1001.068 to read as follows: Sec. 1001.068. CERTAIN OUT-OF-STATE ENGINEERS ENGAGED IN EVALUATING OIL AND GAS RESOURCES. (a) In this section, "evaluation of oil and gas resources" includes: 1-13 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 (1) the quantification of the volume of oil and gas reserves and resources in the subsurface of the earth; 1-17 1-18 (2) the determination of production forecasts for the 1-19 reserves or resources; and 1-20 1-21 (3) the evaluation of the economic impact of the production forecasts. 1-22 (b) This chapter does not apply to the evaluation of oil and gas resources if the evaluation: 1-23 (1) is done by an engineer licensed in a state that does not prohibit engineers licensed under this chapter from engaging in the evaluation of oil and gas resources in that state;

(2) does not involve design, construction, or 1-24 1-25 1-26 1-27 engineering assessments on the surface; and

(3) does not present a risk to public health or safety.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-28 1-29 1-30 1-31 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-32 1-33 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-34 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
