- 2 relating to the authority of a pharmacist to dispense up to a 90-day

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 562.007, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 562.007. REFILLS. Except as provided by Section
- 8 $\underline{562.0545}$, a [A] properly authorized prescription refill shall
- 9 follow the original dispensing instruction unless otherwise
- 10 indicated by the practitioner or the practitioner's agent.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 562, Occupations Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 562.0545 to read as follows:
- Sec. 562.0545. 90-DAY SUPPLY AND ACCELERATED REFILLS. A
- 14 pharmacist may dispense up to a 90-day supply of a dangerous drug
- 15 pursuant to a valid prescription that specifies the dispensing of a
- 16 lesser amount followed by periodic refills of that amount if:
- 17 (1) the total quantity of dosage units dispensed does
- 18 not exceed the total quantity of dosage units authorized by the
- 19 prescriber on the original prescription, including refills;
- 20 (2) the patient consents to the dispensing of up to a
- 21 90-day supply and the physician has been notified electronically or
- 22 by telephone;
- 23 (3) the physician has not specified on the
- 24 prescription that dispensing the prescription in an initial amount

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- 1 followed by periodic refills is medically necessary;
- 2 (4) the dangerous drug is not a psychotropic drug; and
- 3 (5) the patient is at least 18 years of age.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
