- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 140.009 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 140.009. CONTRACT FOR COLLECTION OF DEBTS IN CIVIL
- 8 CASES. (a) The governing body of a municipality or the
- 9 commissioners court of a county may contract with a public or
- 10 private vendor for the collection of a debt owed to the municipality
- 11 or county relating to a civil case, including an unpaid fine, fee,
- 12 or court cost, if the debt is more than 60 days overdue.
- 13 (b) A municipality or county contracting with a vendor under
- 14 Subsection (a) may authorize a collection fee of not more than 30
- 15 percent of the amount of the debt collected. The collection fee may
- 16 be used only to compensate the vendor who collects the debt.
- (c) This section does not apply to the collection of
- 18 commercial bail bonds.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
