## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the filing of writs of habeas corpus in mental health 1-8 1-9 cases.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 1-11 SECTION 1. Section 576.003, Health and Safety Code, is 1-12 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 576.003. WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS. <u>A petition for a writ</u> of habeas corpus must be filed in the court of appeals for the county in which the order is entered. [This subtitle does not limit a person's right to obtain a writ of habeas corpus.] 1-13 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 576.003, Health and Safety Code, applies only to an application for 1-17 1-18 a writ of habeas corpus filed on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a writ of habeas corpus filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect before 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in 1-23 effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-25 1**-**26 1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
