## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the board of trustees of the Teacher
- 3 Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 825.002(d) and (f), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The governor shall appoint two members [one member] of
- 8 the board from a slate of three former members of the retirement
- 9 system who have retired and are receiving benefits from the
- 10 retirement system and who have been nominated in accordance with
- 11 Subsections (f) and (g) by the persons who have retired and are
- 12 receiving benefits from the retirement system. The two members
- 13 <u>hold office for staggered terms.</u>
- 14 (f) Persons considered for nomination under Subsection (c)
- or  $[\tau]$  (d)  $[\tau]$  must have been nominated by written ballot at an
- 16 election conducted under rules adopted by the board of trustees.
- SECTION 2. Section 825.0032(b), Government Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 20 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 21 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 22 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who
- 23 is nominated for appointment under Section 825.002(c) or  $[\tau]$  (d)  $[\tau]$
- 24 or (e)].

- 1 SECTION 3. Sections 825.010(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board of trustees
- 4 that a trustee:
- 5 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the
- 6 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 7 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the
- 8 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 9 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section
- 10 825.002(b) or 825.0032 applicable to the trustee;
- 11 (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge
- 12 the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which
- 13 the trustee is appointed; or
- 14 (5) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 15 scheduled board meetings that the person is eligible to attend
- 16 during a calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority vote
- 17 of the board.
- 18 (c) If the executive director has knowledge that a potential
- 19 ground for removal exists, the executive director shall notify the
- 20 presiding officer of the board of trustees of the ground. The
- 21 presiding officer shall then notify the governor [appropriate
- 22 appointing officer] and the attorney general that a potential
- 23 ground for removal exists. If the potential ground for removal
- 24 involves the presiding officer, the executive director shall notify
- 25 the next highest officer of the board, who shall notify the governor
- 26 [appropriate appointing officer] and the attorney general that a
- 27 potential ground for removal exists.

- 1 SECTION 4. Section 825.002(e), Government Code, is 2 repealed.
- SECTION 5. (a) This Act applies only to the appointment of a trustee of the board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 (b) A person who is serving as a trustee immediately before
  7 the effective date of this Act may complete the trustee's term of
  8 office, and the trustee's qualifications for serving as a trustee
  9 are governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
  10 date of this Act until the date that trustee's term expires.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
