- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 28.053(h), Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (h) The commissioner may enter into agreements with the
- 11 college board and the International Baccalaureate Organization to
- 12 pay for all examinations taken by eligible public school students.
- 13 An eligible student is <u>a student</u> [one] who:
- 14 (1) takes a college advanced placement or
- 15 international baccalaureate course at a public school or who is
- 16 recommended by the student's principal or teacher to take the test;
- 17 and
- 18 (2) demonstrates financial need as determined in
- 19 accordance with guidelines adopted by the board that are consistent
- 20 with the definition of financial need adopted by the college board
- 21 or the International Baccalaureate Organization.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
