A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the display of owner information on and taxes and fees
- 3 applicable to certain coin-operated machines.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 2153, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2153.1591 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2153.1591. DISPLAY OF OWNER INFORMATION. An owner of a
- 8 coin-operated machine subject to this chapter shall prominently
- 9 display the owner's name, address, and phone number on each
- 10 coin-operated machine exhibited or displayed in this state.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 2153.451(b), Occupations Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) As provided by Section 1(f), Article VIII, Texas
- 14 Constitution, the [The] rate of the tax may not exceed one-half
- 15 [one-fourth] of the rate of the tax imposed under Section 2153.401.
- SECTION 3. Section 2153.453, Occupations Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 2153.453. SEALING AUTHORIZED; RELEASE FEE. A county or
- 19 municipality that imposes an occupation tax on a coin-operated
- 20 machine may:
- 21 (1) seal a coin-operated machine if the tax imposed is
- 22 not paid; and
- (2) charge a fee of not more than \$15 $\left[\frac{\$5}{\$}\right]$ for the
- 24 release of a sealed coin-operated machine.

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- 1 SECTION 4. Section 2153.403, Occupations Code, is repealed.
- 2 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding Section 2153.1591, Occupations
- 3 Code, as added by this Act, the owner of a coin-operated machine is
- 4 not required to comply with that section until January 1, 2012.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
