- 5 SECTION 1. Section 10, Article 4413(37), Revised Statutes,
- 6 is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) An insurer shall pay to the authority a fee equal to \$2
- 9 [\$1] multiplied by the total number of motor vehicle years of
- 10 insurance for insurance policies delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 11 renewed by the insurer. The fee shall be paid not later than:
- 12 (1) March 1 of each year for a policy issued,
- 13 delivered, or renewed from July 1 through December 31 of the
- 14 previous calendar year; and
- 15 (2) August 1 of each year for a policy issued,
- 16 delivered, or renewed from January 1 through June 30 of that year.
- (e) Fifty percent of each fee collected under Subsection (b)
- 18 may be appropriated only to the authority for the purposes of this
- 19 article.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an insurance policy issued, delivered, or renewed on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act. An insurance policy issued, delivered,
- 23 or renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 24 law in effect on the date the insurance policy was issued,
