- 8 Sec. 4004.155. [NONAPPLICATION OF] CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS
- 9 APPLICABLE. The continuing education exemptions for certain agents
- 10 established under Section 4004.052(b) and Section 9.02(e), Chapter
- 11 703 (S.B. 414), Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 12 2001, [do not] apply to requirements under this subchapter.
- SECTION 2. Section 4004.202, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 14 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 (b) Each agent described by Subsection (a) must complete
- 17 four hours of continuing education [annually] that specifically
- 18 relates to annuities <u>during the agent's two-year licensing</u>
- 19 period. [The annual period under this section must be based on the
- 20 agent's license expiration date or another date specified by the
- 21 commissioner by rule, and the education requirement under this
- 22 subsection must be met within that annual period, notwithstanding
