1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the power of the Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority to  
1-9 issue bonds.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 8166, Special District Local Laws Code,  
1-12 is amended by adding Subchapter E to read as follows:

1-13 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

1-14 Sec. 8166.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS. (a) The district  
1-15 has the rights, powers, duties, and obligations of an issuer under  
1-16 Chapter 1371, Government Code.

1-17 (b) Section 49.181, Water Code, does not apply to the  
1-18 district.

1-19 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
1-20 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
1-21 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
1-22 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
1-23 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
1-24 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
1-25 Government Code.

1-26 (b) The governor has submitted the notice and Act to the  
1-27 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

1-28 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
1-29 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,  
1-30 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives  
1-31 within the required time.

1-32 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
1-33 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
1-34 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
1-35 and accomplished.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
