- 5 SECTION 1. Section 17.49, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 7 (i) Nothing in this subchapter shall apply to a claim
- 8 against a person licensed as a broker or salesperson under Chapter
- 9 1101, Occupations Code, arising from an act or omission by the
- 10 person while acting as a broker or salesperson, except for a claim
- 11 arising from an unconscionable action or course of action that
- 12 cannot be characterized as advice, judgment, or opinion.
- SECTION 2. Section 17.49(i), Business & Commerce Code, as
- 14 added by this Act, applies only to a claim arising from an act or
- 15 omission that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 16 claim arising from an act or omission that occurred before the
- 17 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 18 date the act or omission occurred, and the former law is continued
- 19 in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
