A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to a fixed tuition rate provided by general academic
- 3 teaching institutions to certain undergraduate students.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 54.016 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 54.016. FIXED TUITION RATE FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS
- 8 AT GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
- 10 Education Coordinating Board.
- 11 (2) "General academic teaching institution" has the
- 12 meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter and
- 14 except as otherwise provided by this section, for a semester or
- 15 other academic term, the governing board of a general academic
- 16 teaching institution may not charge tuition to an undergraduate
- 17 student at a rate that exceeds the rate the institution charged to
- 18 the student during the first semester or other academic term that
- 19 the student enrolled at the institution if the student is currently
- 20 and at all times while enrolled at the institution has been a
- 21 resident of this state for purposes of Subchapter B or was otherwise
- 22 entitled to pay tuition at the rate provided for residents of this
- 23 state.
- (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a student after the

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- 1 fifth anniversary of the date the student first enrolls at any
- 2 public institution of higher education, regardless of whether the
- 3 student transfers among any public or private institutions of
- 4 higher education after the initial enrollment.
- 5 (d) Each general academic teaching institution shall notify
- 6 each entering undergraduate student, including each undergraduate
- 7 student who transfers to the institution, of the eligibility
- 8 requirements for a fixed tuition rate under this section.
- 9 (e) In consultation with the general academic teaching
- 10 <u>institutions</u>, the coordinating board shall adopt any rules the
- 11 coordinating board considers appropriate for the administration of
- 12 this section.
- 13 (f) This section does not apply to a student who enters a
- 14 general academic teaching institution for the first time before the
- 15 2011 fall semester. This subsection expires January 1, 2018.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
