- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 38.103, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:

- 8 SECTION 2. Section 38.103, Education Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 10 (c) The commissioner by rule shall require a school district
- 11 to provide the results of individual student performance on the
- 12 physical fitness assessment instrument to the agency. The results
- 13 may not contain a student's:
- 14 <u>(1) name;</u>
- 15 (2) social security number; or
- 16 (3) date of birth.
- 17 <u>(d)</u> The agency may provide to the comptroller the results
- 18 provided by a school district under Subsection (c) for use in
- 19 identifying areas within a school district appropriate for
- 20 <u>intervention grants relating to health and physical fitness.</u>
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 22 school year.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
