H.B. No. 2211

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the availability of individual student performance on a physical fitness assessment instrument.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The heading to Section 38.103, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 38.103. REPORTING OF ~~[SUMMARY]~~ RESULTS.

SECTION 2. Section 38.103, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

(c) The commissioner by rule shall require a school district to provide the results of individual student performance on the physical fitness assessment instrument to the agency. The results may not contain a student's:

(1) name;

(2) social security number; or

(3) date of birth.

(d) The agency may provide to the comptroller the results provided by a school district under Subsection (c) for use in identifying areas within a school district appropriate for intervention grants relating to health and physical fitness.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012 school year.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
