4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 102.007, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) An adopted budget that will require raising more revenue
8	from property taxes than in the previous year must contain a cover

10	(1) the following statement in 18-point or larger
11	type: "This budget will raise more total property taxes than last
12	year's budget by (insert total dollar amount of increase and
13	percentage increase), and of that amount (insert amount computed by
14	multiplying the proposed tax rate by the value of new property added
15	to the roll) is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to
16	the tax roll this year.";
17	(2) the record vote of each member of the governing
18	body of the municipality regarding:
19	(A) the adoption of the budget;
20	(B) the ratification of the property tax increase
21	under Subsection (c); and
22	(C) the setting of the property tax rate for the
23	current fiscal year; and
24	(3) the municipal property tax rates for the preceding

- and current fiscal years, including: 1 2 (A) the adopted property tax rate; 3 (B) the effective tax rate; 4 (C) the effective maintenance and operations tax 5 rate; and 6 (D) the rollback tax rate. SECTION 2. 7 Section 102.008, Local Government is 8 amended to read as follows: BUDGET WITH MUNICIPAL 9 Sec. 102.008. APPROVED FILED CLERK: POSTING ON INTERNET. On final approval of the budget by the 10 governing body of the municipality, the governing body shall: 11 file the budget with the municipal clerk; and 12 if the municipality maintains an Internet website, 13 14 take action to ensure that: 15 (A) a copy of the budget is posted on the website; 16 and 17 (B) the record votes described by Section 102.007(d)(2) are posted on the website at least until the first 18 19 anniversary of the date the budget is adopted. SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a budget adopted on or 20 after the effective date of this Act. A budget adopted before the 21
