4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 111.008, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) An adopted budget that will require raising more revenue
8	from property taxes than in the previous year must contain a cover

1 and current fiscal years, including: 2 (A) the adopted property tax rate; 3 (B) the effective tax rate; 4 (C) the effective maintenance and operations tax 5 rate; and 6 (D) the rollback tax rate. SECTION 2. Section 111.009, Local Government Code, 7 is 8 amended to read as follows: Sec. 111.009. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH COUNTY CLERK: 9 POSTING ON INTERNET. On final approval of the budget by the 10 commissioners court, the court shall: 11 12 (1) file the budget with the county clerk; and if the county maintains an Internet website, take 13 14 action to ensure that: 15 (A) a copy of the budget is posted on the website; 16 and 17 (B) the record votes described by Section 111.008(d)(2) are posted on the website at least until the first 18 19 anniversary of the date the budget is adopted. SECTION 3. Section 111.039, Local Government Code, 20 is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 21 (d) An adopted budget that will require raising more revenue 22 from property taxes than in the previous year must contain a cover 23 24 page that includes:

- 26 (2) if the county maintains an Internet website, take
- 27 action to ensure that:

1 (A) a copy of the budget is posted on the website; 2 and 3 (B) the record votes described by Section 111.039(d)(2) are posted on the website at least until the first 4 5 anniversary of the date the budget is adopted. 6 SECTION 5. Section 111.068, Local Government Code, 7 amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 8 (c) Adoption of a budget that will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year requires a 9 10 separate vote of the commissioners court to ratify the property tax increase reflected in the budget. A vote under this subsection is 11 12 in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget or a vote to set the tax rate required by Chapter 26, Tax Code, or other 13 14 law. 15 (d) An adopted budget that will require raising more revenue 16 from property taxes than in the previous year must contain a cover 17 page that includes: 18 (1) the following statement in 18-point or larger 19 type: "This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by (insert total dollar amount of increase and 20 percentage increase), and of that amount (insert amount computed by 21 22 multiplying the proposed tax rate by the value of new property added to the roll) is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to 23 24 the tax roll this year."; 25 (2) the record vote of each member of the

12	SECTION 6. Section 111.069, Local Government Code, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Sec. 111.069. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH OFFICERS. On
15	final approval of the budget by the commissioners court, the court
16	shall <u>:</u>
17	(1) file a copy of the budget with the county auditor
18	and the county clerk; and
19	(2) if the county maintains an Internet website, take
20	action to ensure that:
21	(A) a copy of the budget is posted on the website;
22	<u>and</u>
23	(B) the record votes described by Section
24	111.068(d)(2) are posted on the website at least until the first
25	anniversary of the date the budget is adopted.
26	SECTION 7. This Act applies only to a budget adopted on or
27	after the effective date of this Act. A budget adopted before the

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- 1 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 2 budget was adopted, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
