- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 103.001, Civil Practice
- 6 and Remedies Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 103.001. CLAIMANTS ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION AND
- 8 INSURANCE.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 103.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 10 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 11 (d) A person entitled to compensation under Subsection (a)
- 12 is also entitled to group health insurance from the county in which
- 13 the offense that was the subject of the wrongful conviction
- 14 occurred as if the person were an employee of the county.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 103.051, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 17 (f) To apply for coverage under a county employee group
- 18 health insurance plan under Section 103.001(d), the claimant must
- 19 file:
- (1) an application for coverage provided for that
- 21 purpose by the county; and
- 22 (2) a statement by the comptroller that the
- 23 comptroller has determined the claimant to be eligible for
- 24 compensation under this subchapter.

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- 1 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 2 person the comptroller has determined to be eligible for
- 3 compensation as provided by Section 103.051(b), Civil Practice and
- 4 Remedies Code, regardless of whether the eligibility determination
- 5 is made before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
