- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 44.031, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (n) to read as follows:
- 8 (n) A school district contract to which Subsection (a)
- 9 applies under which the district contracts with another entity for
- 10 that entity to manage or otherwise provide food services at one or
- 11 more district schools must require that any other contract the
- 12 entity makes in performance of its duties under the contract with
- 13 the district and to which Subsection (a) would apply if the district
- 14 were making the contract be made:
- 15 (1) under the method listed by Subsection (a) that
- 16 provides the best value to the entity and the district;
- 17 (2) with consideration of the factors specified under
- 18 Subsection (b) and, as applicable, under Subsection (b-1), in

- 20 (3) as provided by Subsection (g).
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 44.031(n), Education Code, as added by
- 22 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the

- 1 or more district schools. A contract entered into before the
- 2 effective date of this Act by a school district with another entity
- 3 for that entity to manage or otherwise provide food services at one
- 4 or more district schools is governed by the law in effect on the
- 5 date the contract was entered into, and that law is continued in
- 6 effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
