- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 21.257, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (a-1) A determination by the hearing examiner regarding
- 9 good cause for the suspension of a teacher without pay or the
- 10 termination of a probationary, continuing, or term contract is a
- 11 conclusion of law and may be adopted, rejected, or changed by the
- 12 board of trustees or board subcommittee as provided by Section
- 13 21.259(b).
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 21.259(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (b) The board of trustees or board subcommittee may adopt,
- 17 reject, or change the hearing examiner's:
- 18 (1) conclusions of law, including a determination
- 19 regarding good cause for suspension without pay or termination; or
- 20 (2) proposal for granting relief.
- 21 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a hearing examiner's determination regarding good cause that is
- 23 contained in a written recommendation under Section 21.257,
- 24 Education Code, issued on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
