12	SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES
13	Sec. 8370.101. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
14	DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
15	general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
16	applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
17	Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
18	Sec. 8370.102. NO ALLOCATION AGREEMENT. Section 54.016(f),
