1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the powers and duties of the Montgomery County
1-10 Municipal Utility District No. 112.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
1-13 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8370 to read as follows:

1-14 CHAPTER 8370. MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 112

1-15 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1-16 Sec. 8370.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district"
1-17 means the Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 112.

1-18 [Sections 8370.002-8370.100 reserved for expansion]

1-19 SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES

1-20 Sec. 8370.101. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
1-21 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
1-22 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
1-23 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
1-24 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

1-25 Sec. 8370.102. NO ALLOCATION AGREEMENT. Section 54.016(f),
1-26 Water Code, does not apply to the district.

1-27 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
1-28 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
1-29 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
1-30 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
1-31 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
1-32 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
1-33 Government Code.

1-34 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
1-35 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
1-36 Environmental Quality.

1-37 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
1-38 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
1-39 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
1-40 representatives within the required time.

1-41 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
1-42 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
1-43 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
1-44 and accomplished.

1-45 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
