A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to amendment of restrictions in certain residential real estate subdivisions. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 211.001(4), Property Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 (4) "Residential 7 real estate subdivision" οr "subdivision" means all land encompassed within one or more maps or 8 9 plats of land that is divided into two or more parts if: 10 (A) the maps or plats cover land all or part of 11 which [that] is not located within a municipality and: 12 (i) for a county with a population of less than 65,000, is not located [or] within the extraterritorial 13 jurisdiction of a municipality; or 14 (ii) for a county with a population of at 15 least 65,000 and less than 135,000, is located wholly within the 16 extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality; 17 18 (B) the land encompassed within the maps or plats is or was burdened by restrictions limiting all or at least a 19 majority of the land area covered by the map or plat, excluding 20 streets and public areas, to residential use only; and 21 (C) all instruments creating the restrictions 22 23 are recorded in the deed or real property records of a county. SECTION 2. Section 211.002(a), Property Code, is amended to 24

read as follows: 1 2 (a) This chapter applies only to a residential real estate 3 subdivision or any unit or parcel of a subdivision: (1) all or part of which is located [in whole or in 4 part] within an unincorporated area of a county if the county has a 5 6 population of less than 65,000; or 7 (2) all of which is located within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality located in a county 8 that has a population of at least 65,000 and less than 135,000. 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011. 10
